I am writing to you as our records show that you are the owner of the above property, the property is privately rented and it has an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of F or G.

Since 1st April 2016 the above. Regulations have required landfords to comply with a minimum level of energy efficiency. From 1 April 2000, these requirements apply to entire the rest of the properties not just when a new tenancy begins. If you rent a property with an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) calling of Fro II (and have not applied for an exemption) you may be committing an offence of letting a substandard property and risk a financial penally of up to \$4,000.

Government guidance has been published to assist landlords to understand the Regulations, available from https://www.mendip.gov.uk/energyefficiency under Energy Performance and Cold Homes.

DOMESTIC MINIMUM ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS (MEES)


...came into force in England and Wales on 1 April 2018, applies to private rented residential and non-domestic property and is aimed at encouraging landlords and property owners to improve the energy efficiency of their properties by a restriction on the granting and continuation of existing tenancies where the property has an Energy Performance Certificate Rating of F and G.










